Description: While serving as 1992-93 governor of the Illinois-Eastern Iowa Kiwanis District, Brian Cunat and his wife, Miki, established this scholarship to recognize and support Kiwanis-family members who are setting out to make a difference in people’s lives as they work their way through school.

The Cunats have been believers in setting goals, staying the course and accomplishing goals. Life goals should be not only self-serving, but include the concept of helping others and making the world a better place for all.

Criteria: College-bound Key Club International member

Required Attachments: Attach a 200-word essay describing how your studies will help you achieve your goals, while benefitting the lives of others. Additionally, include two letters of recommendation originally signed and dated and no more than two pages in length that describe how you are beginning this “life to benefit others.” The letters should be from a fellow Key Club member and a Kiwanis or faculty advisor to the Key Club. Please do NOT send information beyond what is requested. Any such extraneous information will disqualify your application from consideration.
