

TAKE THE CHALLENGE.

Kiwanis International turned 100 in January. To celebrate our rich history of service, The Eliminate Project challenges your CKI members to do something extreme to help save babies. You'll have fun and make history in the process. Here's how:

1 SET YOUR GOAL AND STUNT

Choose a fundraiser and estimate what you'll raise. This is your fundraising goal. Next, pick a funny stunt or extreme local tradition (like kissing an octopus) for your CKI club to complete when you reach your goal. This will motivate people to give and build club spirit—which will ultimately help your members save more moms and babies from maternal and neonatal tetanus.

PLAN YOUR PROJECT

Get your project off the ground. Set a date, budget and task list for your fundraising activity. Assign responsibilities. You can find the toolkits and resources you need at www.TheEliminateProject.org/SLP.

3 MAKE IT HAPPEN

Before your event, spread the word about MNT, your fundraiser and the stunt you'll perform once your goal is reached—invite people to give and help save babies. Consider creating a team fundraising page where you can collect people's donations at www.TheEliminateProject.org/personalpage. Whether you host a dance, shave your head or simply invite club members to donate, your club will make a difference. Don't forget to ask your sponsoring Kiwanis club to match the funds you raise and dare them to participate in the stunt. You'll double your lifesaving impact in the process.

4 TURN IN FUNDS

Get credit from The Eliminate Project and possibly add some patches to your club's banner. Complete a Kiwanis-family giving form and send the money your club raised to the Kiwanis International Foundation. Find details at www.TheEliminateProject.org/SLPrecognition.

5 CELEBRATE
